Americans with Disabilities Act

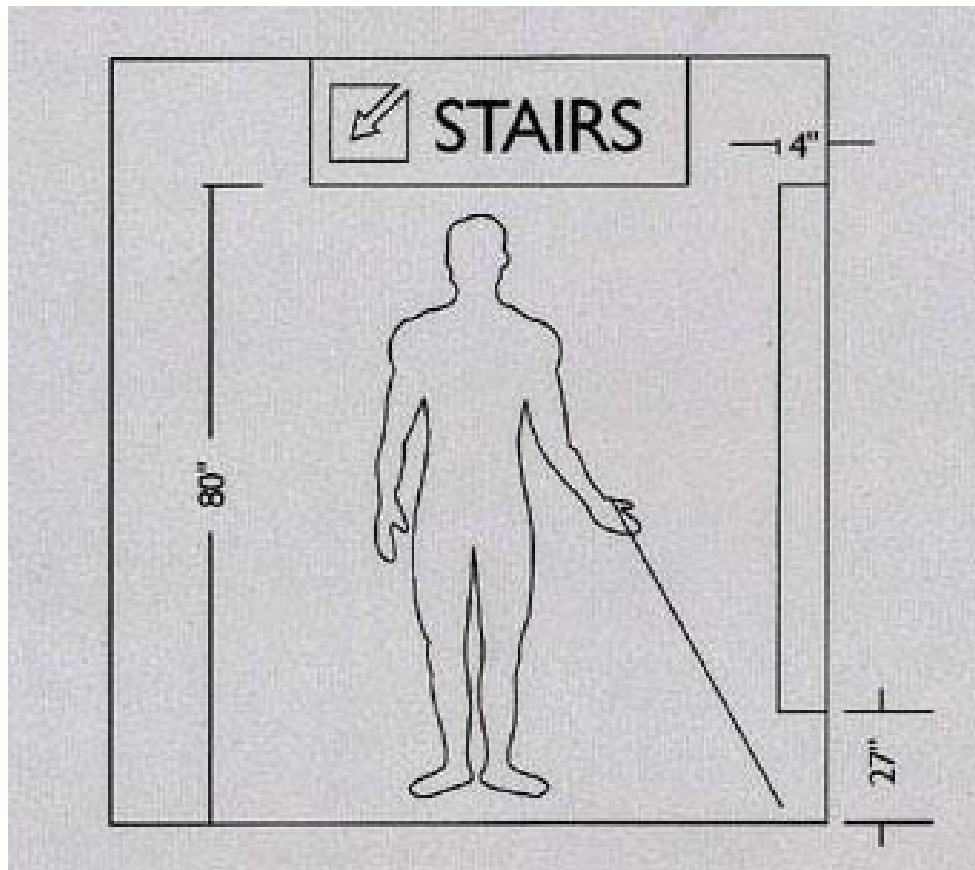
On July 26, 1990 a national act against discrimination of persons with disabilities came to pass. The act refers to several fields, namely: Public Services, Telecommunications, Transportation and Employment.

The Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board published guidelines for manufacturers and designers of: wall sconces, lighting, fountains, phone booths and the like for them to comply with the act.

The general requirements are as follows:

80" head room at all walkways, corridors and halls.

All objects mounted on the walls, that are between 27" and 80" should not project more than 4" into the walkway. *RENAISSANCE*, is proud to be part of the ADA act, and therefore presents an extensive line of ADA fixtures to meet this requirement.
